1. Championship

This is the Sporting Regulations for: **Nordic Championship Nordic 4/Formula Nordic 2025.** These Sporting Regulations come into force from the moment they are published on respectively ASN web-cite where possible changes, bulletins etc, will be published.

Nordic 4 (Danish) and Formula Nordic (Swedish) compete together for the Nordic Championship. Points (qualification and race heats) are awarded in the respective competition class. Points achieved in the respective class are combined in a common championship table. (Ref. § 6 below).

The winner of the **Formula NC 2025** is the driver awarded most points after the last race heat. In the case of two or more drivers having the same number of points after the last race heat, the result of the last heat decides the ranking for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall. If still equal points, then the second last race heat come into force a.s.o.

2. Title and Jurisdiction

The **Formula NC 2025** is handled by the Nordic RA Commission in association with respectively ASN's Racing Commissions and the promotors for Formula Nordic and Nordic4. The entrants are enforced to follow the General Sporting Regulations from hosting ASN. Competitors must ensure that their cars comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout qualifying and racing.

3. Eligible Drivers

The events will be national and are open to drivers with an appropriate, valid driver's license, including startingpermission from their respectively ASN.

4. Eligible Cars

Formula Nordic: Totally according to Formula Nordic Reglemente 2025 (in swedish). **Nordic 4:** Totally according to Nordic 4 Reglemang (in danish).

Each heat will count towards the Formula NC. Points will be awarded based as below.

Qualification/Bonus points

Timed qualification gives bonus points in each Competition class for starting position in raceheat 1 according to:

1st - 5 points; 2nd - 4 points; 3rd - 3 points; 4th - 2 points; 5th - 1 point.
